

Cars and Parts for Sale and Wanted

Advertising in this section of the website is free to CPUK members (log-in for details).

Non-members can advertise in this section for a one-off fee of £5 (up to 3 photos included). Adverts will normally run for 1 month but, if required, the advert can be renewed for a further month free of charge (up to a maximum of 2 renewals)

Ads should be submitted by email (with photos attached) to:

Non-members should send their cheque to CPUK, Rose Cottage, Eathorpe, Leamington Spa CV33 9DE or [pay by credit card via our online shop](#). Once we receive your payment we'll upload your ad.

All car parts and any cars under £100 can be advertised free of charge by non-members. Simply submit your ad to the same email address as for paid ads.

Please tell us when you sell your car/parts so that we can remove your advertisement. This avoids annoying phone calls for you and frustration for potential buyers. Just email classified@clubpeugeotuk.org, including the advertisement header and your name.

All adverts will be automatically removed from the website after 1 month and only reactivated on receipt of a 1 month extension request from the seller.

We recommend that advertisers include their name, location (county is sufficient) and contact telephone number (with any calling time restrictions, such as office hours only). An expected price helps to exclude timewasters.

If you are a trader, it is a legal requirement to add "Trader" at the end of the advertisement.

PLEASE READ BEFORE SUBMITTING AN AD

The internet is a great place to sell your car but beware there are many scams about. Sometimes the scammer is obvious but other times not so.

A common internet scam is the offer to buy your car for more than the offer price. The scammer may offer to pay using a bankers draft or cheque. This scam works because of the little know fact that both bankers drafts and cheques can be cancelled even AFTER the money has cleared into your account, sometimes up to six months after!! BEWARE, you will lose both your car and your money.

Our best advice is to be cautious. The number one rule is that if it appears too good to be true then it usually is.

If you place your car for sale here and receive a scam attempt to buy the car please let us know. If it's a new scam we'll add the scam to this notice to help protect other sellers.
